POOL SAFETY AND REGULATIONS

Read all rules below, on walls of pool, and facility restrooms for your safety and the safety of others.

- **Maximum Capacity in the pool facility is 100 people**
- **No shoes in the pool area**
- **Swimsuits only.**
- **No bags, personal items, glass** or toys are allowed in the pool area;** If you wish to secure your items, please ensure you bring a lock with you. ***Locks must be removed from lockers at the end of the session and will be cut off if not removed.***
- **No food or drink in the pool area, other than water.**
- **No one is allowed in the pool area without a lifeguard present**
- **No one is allowed in the pool without showering first in locker room showers**
- **Sick? Do not Swim.**
- **No open wounds allowed.**
- **Stomach problems “Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days.” N.J. Admin. Code § 8:26-5.4**
- **Children in diapers must wear diapers specially designed for immersion in water (such as swimming diapers).**
- **Not allowed to pee or poop in the pool.**
- **No pets allowed** except for service animals **trained to the requirements of a person with a disability. The ADA does not override public health rules that prohibit dogs in swimming pools.** For a trained service animal to gain pool access it must be registered with Tranquility Camp Pool Staff at WilmarsP@tranquilitycamp.org
- **No underage children** are allowed in the pool area **without adult supervision.**
- Only two (2) adult supervisors per group, per session
- As a Christian establishment, public displays of affections are discouraged in pool area.
- Inappropriate behavior and foul language are not allowed in pool area.
- The unsafe use of the pool by either a person or group may lead to be asked to leave by Tranquility Camp Staff or lifeguard on duty, no refunds.
- No running.
- No diving.
- No loud music, no sound system.
- Lifeguards **have the right** to ask a patron to leave the pool area at any time without a refund.
